Your search looks like this:







## Changing a Question into a Query



You can actually write down your question:

My 1-year-old cow has blisters on its tongue, what is wrong with it?

Break the question into individual concepts:

- My 1-year-old cow
- has blisters
- on its tongue
- what is wrong with it?

Try this search: [cow blister tongue]

## Improving Your Query: Getting All the Ideas



#### [cow blister tongue]

Are there any ideas missing from the original question?

What is wrong with it?

What are you really asking? You want to know if the cow is sick.

Try this search: [cow blister tongue sick]

## Improving Your Query: Level of Formality



#### [cow blister tongue sick]

Think again about who might be answering this question on the Web.

Would formal sources use other words?

cattle instead of cow.

Try this search: [cattle blister tongue sick]

### What My Source Says



## Australia's Department of Primary Industries gives a list of signs of Foot & Mouth Disease, including:

- Blisters (vesicles) appear within a few hours after the animal becomes sick. They may appear around
  the tops of the claws or between them, on udders and teats, and on the nose, lips, gums, tongue and
  inside the mouth.
- The blisters vary in appearance. On the surface of the tongue of cattle they may rapidly develop to a length of 20-50 mm or more, with an irregular edge, and the surface of the blisters may be much paler than the surrounding tissues.

		Every word matters. Simplify, and only use words you really need.								
1		Try searching for [who], [the who], and [a who]								
		Order matters.								
2	2	Try searching for [blue sky] and [sky blue]								
		Capitalization does not matter.								
3	3	Try searching for [john okafor], [John Okafor], and [jOHn oKaFor]								
4	1	Punctuation does not matter.								
		Try searching for ['harambee; stars?] and [harambee stars]								
*		There are some exceptions!								
		\$500 (meaning money) C++ or C# (programming languages)								

### Tips For Better Searches



Keep it simple. Describe what you want in as few terms as possible. It makes your life--and often your results--easier.

[quit smoking] not [I have smoked for five years, how can I quit?]


But not too simple! Make sure to represent the ideas in your problem.

[steam engine diagram] not [train]

- Once you know what your question is, think about the answer to the question, instead. How will it be written? Build your search from that. [corona "0 to 100"] not [how fast can a corona accelerate?]
- Use descriptive, specific words. Avoid general or common words. [vj bibanda] not [vj video hall] (the words video and hall have too many uses).





## Google Search Operators



\*\* \*\*

An operator is a symbol or command that modifies the words or numbers around it.

In search, an operator changes your search query -- often with drastic results!





These operators can help you tweak, refine, and narrow your search.

There are nine basic operators in Google Search.



Reading level sorts results into beginning, intermediate, and advanced, based on vocabulary level and sentence structure

Results per pages sets the number of links on each results page

Language lets you search in various languages

File type filetype: search [ugali filetype:pdf]

Search within a site or domain site: search [arts site:ncdc.go.ug]

## Advanced Search Page: A Closer Look (III)

Date: (how recent the page is)	anytime	<b>\$</b>
Usage rights:	not filtered by license	•
Where your keywords show up:	anywhere in the page	•
Region:	any region	•

Date sets how new a page needs to be (past week, month, etc.)

Usage rights finds sources from which you can reuse the content in specified ways (such as copying it, modifying it, etc.)

Where your keywords show up looks for certain words just in the title, web address (URL), page text, etc.

**Region** sets area of the world where the website is put on the Web

## Advanced Search Page: A Closer Look (IV)

Numeric range:

**Number range** finds any number between two specified values, like the search: [220..230].

SafeSearch helps filter out adult content, such as pornography. You can set more precise controls under your Search Preferences.

## Advanced Search Page: A Closer Look (V)

Page-specific tools:	
Find pages similar to the page:	Search
Find pages that link to the page:	Search

Find pages similar to the page looks for pages on topics similar to one you like. Same as using related: in basic search, like this: [related:beyonceonline.com].

Finds pages that link to the page identifies webpages that link to a particular page. Same as using link: in basic search, like this: [link:health.go.ug].




